FINAL JUDGMENT

The court finds that Defendant Advanced Credit Recovery, Inc. was served with citation and a true and correct copy of the Plaintiff's Original Petition and Request for Disclosure on February 1, 2010. The court finds the deadline for Advanced Credit Recovery, Inc. to file an answer was March 8, 2010. However, the court finds Advanced Credit Recovery, Inc. did not file an answer or any other papers in this case and/or otherwise make an appearance. Moreover, the court finds that the return and certificate of service have been on file with the clerk at least ten (10) days, excluding the day of filing and today. Finally, the court finds that the Plaintiff's Motion for Final Default Judgment Against Defendant Advanced Credit Recovery, Inc. should be and is in all things GRANTED.

It is therefore ORDERED the Plaintiff, Eddie E. Roberts, shall recover from Advanced Credit Recovery, Inc. \$25,000.00 in mental anguish damages, \$1,357.00 attorneys' fees through the filing of the motion for default judgment, \$7,500.00 for any unsuccessful appeal by Defendant Advanced Credit Recovery, Inc. to the Amarillo Court of Appeals, \$7,500.00 for any unsuccessful appeal by Defendant Advanced Credit Recovery, inc. to the Texas Supreme Court, all costs of court, and post-

judgment interest at the rate of five percent (5%) per annum on the total of these amounts from the date of this judgment until the judgment is paid in full.

It is further ORDERED that the Plaintiff shall be allowed such writs and processes as may be necessary in the enforcement and collection of this judgment.

All relief not expressly granted is denied. This judgment disposes of all issues and parties in this case and is final for purposes of appeal.
